- Please e-mail, fax or mail any necessary paperwork to us.

- NJ Workers Compensation Courts are currently closed until Friday, April 3, 2020.
- NJ Municipal Courts are currently closed through March 27, 2020.
- NJ Superior Court for Civil, Criminal and Family are not starting new jury trials. Most in-person hearings have been postponed, or converted to phone or video conference, where possible.
- The Mercer County Surrogate's Office is closed except for emergent matters.
